

New I-9 Released

McGohan Brabender would like to notify you that on Wednesday, November 7, 2007, the USCIS (US Citizenship & Immigration Services) released a revised Employment Eligibility Verification Form (I-9), which is now available for use.

It is a federal requirement that U.S. employers complete an I-9 form for all employees within the first three days of employment. They must retain the form for one year after termination of employment, or three years, whichever is longer. While employers may start using the form immediately, it will officially become effective when posted in the federal register at a later date.
