

Pharmacies Leaving Medco Network

McGohan Brabender has received word that on December 28, 2007, Medco sent letters notifying approximately 2,000 Medical Mutual members that pharmacies they currently use chose to leave the Medco network effective January 1, 2008. The letter gave each recipient the name and location of three local in-network alternatives. Medco did not notify Medical Mutual prior to sending this letter. A copy of the letter is attached for your reference. Please note that no major or minor chain pharmacies located in Ohio are affected.

The letter also indicated that Walters Pharmacy, Pack Pharmacy, Fulton County Health Center, The Prescription Center and Pickerington Pharmacy had exited the network.

However, these pharmacies have recently rejoined the Medco network. Benefits at these pharmacies will be paid retroactively to January 1, 2008.
